This intermediate-level workshop is intended for individuals who are familiar with the MMPI-2 who wish to learn how to use the most recent, up-to-date version of the instrument, the MMPI-2-RF. The workshop includes an overview of the MMPI-2-RF, a discussion of the rationale for, and methods used to develop the test, a description of the 51 scales of the inventory and the documentation available to guide its use, guidelines for MMPI-2-RF interpretation, and case illustrations.

Learning Objectives. After attending the workshop, participants will be able to:

- 1. Identify the rationale for, and methods used in revising the MMPI-2
- 2. Describe the 51 scales of the MMPI-2-RF
- 3. Utilize MMPI-2-RF material and documentation
- 4. Administer and score the MMPI-2-RF following standard procedures
- 5. Use MMPI-2-RF Comparison Group data
- 6. Interpret the MMPI-2-RF

Yossef Ben-Porath is a Professor of Psychology at Kent State University. He received his doctoral training at the University of Minnesota and has been involved extensively in MMPI research for the past 28 years. He is a co-developer of the MMPI-2-RF and co-author of test manuals, books, book chapters, and articles on the MMPI instruments. He is currently Associate Editor and incoming Editor of the journal *Psychological Assessment*, and former Editor of the journal *Assessment*. His clinical practice involves supervision of assessments at Kent State's Psychological Clinic, consultation to agencies that screen candidates for public safety positions and provision of consultation and expert witness services in forensic cases.
